IRS, NY & Other States Extend Filing Deadline to July 15

The IRS, NY, and most other states have extended the tax filing and payment deadline to July 15, 2020. However, we are still encouraging all clients to send us their tax information as soon as possible. Our goal is to prepare as many or all returns by the original tax deadline of April 15th. Please keep in mind that even if your return is filed by April 15th, the tax payment can be delayed until July 15th. The 1Q estimated tax payment due 4/15 has also been extended to 7/15.

We have recently learned that NY has deemed Accounting an essential service which means we are allowed in the office. However, in trying to stay healthy and doing our part to limit the spread of this virus, most of us here at Zulch Tax are working from home. We are allowed to go in to the office to pick up work as needed, and will continue to pick up the mail and items in the dropbox.

Please note: There is no way to change the date from 4/15 to 7/15 for any clients whose tax return has already been e-filed with the tax payment set to auto withdraw on 4/15. If we learn of a way this can be changed, we will let you know.
